Parked next to the notice board in the middle of the village, there is a car that you can use for as little a 30 minutes or for as long as you like. Just join, book the car, drive – and get a single bill each month.

Pairing up with Commonwheels means that it's not just one car. There's already an Berlingo "people carrier" that you can use just like the Staveley car in Kendal, plus cars at another 15 locations around the country.

So mix it up — Staveley's pretty well catered for with trains, buses and easy cycling and walking. Now with access to a car when you need it, the village just gets an even better place to live.

Questions, questions...

How do I join?

Either log on to <u>www.commonwheels.org.uk</u> or phone 0845 602 8030. It only takes a few minutes. Once this is done Commonwheels will check your license with the DVLA and send you your smart card.

How much does it cost?

Joining:

- > There's a one-off fee of £25 for the DVLA check
- > Returnable insurance deposit £150 or free if you sign-up to direct debit.

Using the cars:

- > The hourly rate is £3.25 plus 19p per mile
- > The 24 hour daily rate is £27 plus 19p per mile
- There is a minimum monthly spend of £5 which goes as credit against bookings.

... but that's hardly cheap!

- > This includes all charges tax, insurance, servicing and fuel... just fill up with the car's fuel card.
